Attention Parents!

End of School Medication Policy

If your child has medicine at school a parent will need to pick it up in the nurse's office by Tuesday, May 29th.

Any medicine Not picked up by a parent will be taken to the police station disposal. This includes both pre-scription and over the counter medicine.

Also, reminder of the importance of sunscreen use for your child. Sunburns can cause damage to young sensitive skin!

Last, incoming 6th graders will need additional immunizations: one Tdap, one meningococcal vaccine, and 2 Hepatitis A vaccines. Make your appointment soon!
